

### Boost Up Referral Criteria

Factor	Eligibility
Age	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Client must be older than 18 and younger than 25 to be accepted onto the scheme.</li> </ul>
Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>B1 Level [Threshold or Intermediate]</li> <li>Can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.</li> <li>Can produce simple connected text on topics that are familiar or of personal interest.</li> </ul>
Employment Status	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is not earning more than £700 per month in a contracted job</li> </ul>
Eligible for work	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is able to work and has demonstrated a willingness to do so.</li> </ul>
Has Recourse to Public Funds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has recourse to public funds and this can receive the housing component of UC or Housing Benefit.</li> </ul>
Housing Condition	<p>Client is either</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rough Sleeping</li> <li>In temporary accommodation</li> <li>In supported accommodation and is ready to move on</li> <li>In insecure accommodation which will likely lead to their homelessness if there is no intervention</li> </ul>
Behavior/Attitude	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Client is fully willing to engage with the scheme and accepts what will be expected of them</li> <li>Client is assessed as appropriate to reside in shared accommodation.</li> </ul>
Mental and Physical Health	<p>Client is not</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Alcohol dependent</li> <li>Drug Dependent</li> <li>Diagnosed with a mental health condition but is refusing to take recommended medication</li> </ul>
Criminal record	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No convictions for murder/rape/sexual assault</li> <li>If client has a conviction for GBH or ABH the caseworker may refuse based on a comprehensive risk assessment</li> </ul>
