Please make a note of the new number on the front of this leaflet. **Please make sure you have a note of the address where your future appointments will be.**

For some people, who do not have named workers, but have appointments with members of





the Depot & Wellbeing Clinic, please make a note of the new address on your appointment letter.

We will be running the Depot and Wellbeing Clinic from two buildings. We will let you know which one to come to. However, the main office will be in Fairlight Avenue. This will be the best place to contact us if you need support.

In future, we will also run a Depot & Wellbeing clinic from:
